General Functions:

Under the direction of the Aquatics Director and/or Aquatics Coordinator, provides leadership, instruction, and motivation for participants in swimming classes.

Work Schedule is Mon-Friday 9:30am-1pm, Mon-Thurs 4pm-6:30pm plus Sat & Sun 9:30am-12:30pm

Responsibilities/Functions/Duties/Tasks

The essential functions of this position include but are not limited to the following:

- Instructs swimming classes as assigned in accordance with YMCA guidelines.
- Develops positive relationships with members and participants and provides motivational support and guidance.
- Encourages member and parent involvement and identifies potential volunteers.
- Conveys information on aquatics programs and schedules and as appropriate refers members and participants to other programs.
- Maintains records as required.
- Attends staff meetings and trainings as required.
- Follows all YMCA policies, rules, regulations and procedures including emergency safety procedures and completes applicable paperwork.
- Manages class equipment, including procurement and storage. Reports damaged equipment.
- Trains and supervises class aides as assigned.
- Attends required meetings and events, completes required training and responds to inquiries in a timely manner. Meetings may be held at other branches and other locations.
- Identifies and responds to child abuse according to YMCA Youth Protection Plan.
- All other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience:

- At least 16 years of age
- Be able to demonstrate swim instructor skills in accordance with YMCA standards.
- Ability to lift equipment and lift/maneuver children during swim lessons.
- Within 6 months of hire receive certifications in: CPR for the Professional Rescuer; AED; Basic First Aid; YMCA Swim Instructor.
